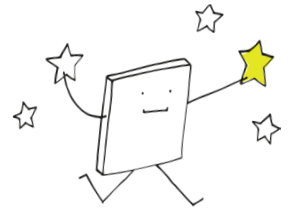


Music



EYFS:

- Read and sing a variety of nursery rhymes with your child. Which one is their favourite?
- Ask your child to think about how some musical instruments are played, for example bang a drum, tap a tambourine, shake the maracas. Write out the words and encourage your child to trace them.



Key Stage 1:

- Visit [BBC School Radio](#) and ask your child to listen to the programme Instruments Together. Encourage them to design a poster for a concert – who will be performing? What instruments will be played?
- Visit [Book Trust](#) and read along to the story Every Bunny Dance. Can your child recount the story?



Years 3/4:

- Ask your child to find the lyrics to their favourite song and highlight some creative words used, finding out the meaning of new words.

- Ask your child to find the lyrics to their favourite song and to create some new verses.
