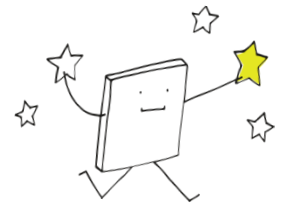


Rainforests



EYFS:

- Help your child to look through cookery books for a recipe involving cocoa/chocolate.
- Ask your child to create an animal from the rainforest then talk about the sounds that different animals make.



Key Stage 1:

Years 5/6:
