

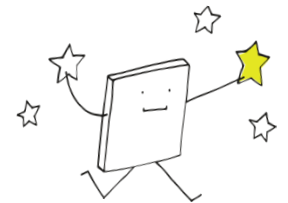


Sport



EYFS:

- Talk to your child about some words used in sports such as throw, hit, catch, ball. Go on a word hunt around the house to find these words in books, magazines or newspapers.
- Develop listening skills by encouraging your child to listen to the BBC Schools Radio episode about sports [here](#).



Key Stage 1:

- Ask your child to play the Solve, Shoot, Score spelling game on the [Premier League Primary Stars](#) website. Encourage your child to write down the words spelt and add sound buttons.



Years 3/4:

- Visit [World Book Online](#) and log in using Username: wbsupport and Password: distancelearn. Select eBooks and search for the title Play Sports! and ask your child to read the ebook. Encourage them to complete the activities at the back of the book.
- Ask your child to devise their own sport, including rules, equipment and a scoring system. Try the game out!



Years 5/6:

- Ask your child to read the sports pages of a newspaper and consider the language used. Ask them to write two newspaper articles on a sport of their choice, one reporting on an event and the other reporting 'behind the scenes'. Pay attention to the different language that will be used in each.
