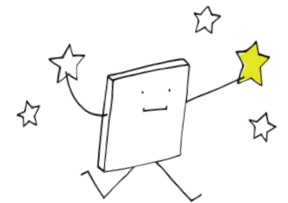


Transport



EYFS:

- Sing the nursery rhyme Wheels on the Bus with your child. Can they add verses about different modes of transport? What sounds and actions do other kinds of transport make?
- Visit [BBC Bitesize](#) and follow the story The Bus is for Us with your child. Ask them about the different types of transport mentioned in the story.



Key Stage 1:

- Look through a newspaper or magazine and list the different types of transport found.
- Visit [World Book Online](#) and log in using Username: wbsupport and Password: distancelearn. Select eBooks and search for the title Tough Trucks and read with your child.



Years 3/4:

- Encourage your child to find a car advert in a magazine or newspaper and find the meaning of any new terms, especially technical ones.
- Ask your child to read the poem [Look at the Train!](#) at the Poetryline website. Ask them to write their own poem about a mode of transport using onomatopoeia to evoke sounds and rhythm.



Years 5/6:

- Ask your child to look at a car manual and look up any new technical terms. Encourage them to design their own manual for a vehicle of their choice.
- Ask your child to look for leaflets, newspaper articles or other literature about transport. What does the information tell them about how we use transport today? What could be improved?
